- Wednesday 8.30am 4.30pm
- To be available to provide, on a rota basis, occasional Saturday cover for Bath Farmers' Market

Duties and responsibilities

- To take on picking and packing responsibilities as needed to ensure the smooth running of the business.
- □ Some van driving required
- □ Be an enthusiastic and committed ambassador for the Community Farm and its key objectives of environmental sustainability and community engagement.
- Develop clear and open methods of communication with other staff of the community farm.
